The Coimbatore team opened their innings with a thunderous batting display and posted a total of 140 runs on the scoreboard. In reply, Chennai South started their chase with great determination, showing remarkable focus on preserving their wickets right from the beginning. Their disciplined batting and steady scoring led them to a thumping victory over Coimbatore. After the match, the players of both teams were formally introduced and congratulated by the office bearers, adding to the spirit of camaraderie and sportsmanship.

The second day of the tournament began on 16th August 2025 at 8.00 AM, with exciting matches lined up between the finalized teams.
